I am directed to refer to your letter dated 4.10.2006 accepting the terms and conditions contained in this Ministry's letter of even no. dated 29.9.2006 and furnishing the Performance Bank Guarantee No.07/06, dated 3.10.2006 for Rs.100 lakhs, valid for 5 years, i.e. up to 3.10.2011, issued by United Bank of India, Pune, and an additional PBG No.08/06, dated 3.10.2006 for Rs.100 lakhs, valid for one year, i.e. up to 3.10.2007, issued by United Bank of India, Pune, for completion of own hospital project within the campus of the dental college, and to convey the formal Permission of the Central Government under section 10A (4) of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 to Sinhgad Technical Education Society, Vadgaon (Budruk), Pune, Maharashtra, for establishment of a new dental college, 'Sinhgad Dental College & Hospital', at Vadgaon (BK), Pune, Maharashtra, with an annual admission capacity of 50 students in BDS Course from the academic session, 2006-2007.

2. This permission is valid for only one year and for admitting only one batch of students to BDS Course in the dental college during the academic session 2006-2007. The admission should be made strictly in accordance with the direction issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on 29.9.2006.

3. The Central Government Permission will be renewed on yearly basis after verification of the achievement of annual targets. The next batch of students will be admitted in the college only after renewal of Central Government Permission for 2nd year BDS Course in the college.

4. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action under Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 will be initiated.

Subject: Permission for annual intake capacity of 100 seats at Sinhgad Dental College & Hospital, at Vadgaon(BK), Pune, Maharashtra the academic session 2007-08 onwards.

Sir,

In pursuance of Order dated 10.11.2006 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the Writ Petition No.321 of 2006 in the matter of Rishiraj Memorial Education & Welfare Society, Bhopal Vs UOI & Anr alongwith SLP bearing No. 15840 of 2006, Dental Council of India, vide their letter dated 30.1.2007, have recommended to the Central Government to allow the admission with annual intake of 100 seats in place of 50 seats at Sinhgad Dental College & Hospital, at Vadgaon (BK), Pune, Maharashtra for the academic session 2007-08 onwards after obtaining the additional performance bank guarantee of Rs. 100 Lakhs from the college authorities.

2. In view of the above recommendations of Dental Council of India, the Central Government has come to the conclusion that a Letter Of Intent may be issued to the authorities of Sinhgad Dental College & Hospital, at Vadgaon (BK), Pune, Maharashtra to allow the admission capacity of 100 seats in place of 50 seats in their dental college for the academic session 2007-08 onwards after obtaining an additional performance bank guarantee of Rs. 100 Lakhs valid for 4 years.

3. This Letter of Intent is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions;

- (I) The additional teaching and non-teaching staff shall be recruited as per DCI norms.
- (II) The applicant has a feasible and time bound programme to provide additional equipment and infrastructure facilities as per DCI norms.
- (III) The applicant will furnish the Performance Bank Guarantee of Rs.100 lakhs valid for 4 years in favour of DCI.
- (IV) Admission for BDS Course in the proposed dental college will be made ONLY after receipt of formal permission to that effect from the Central Government.

4. The formal permission will be granted after you accept the above conditions and furnish the requisite Performance Bank Guarantee immediately failing which it will be presumed that the applicants are not interested in pursuing the subject matter and accordingly the case will be closed without further correspondence in the matter.

5. While existing regulations make it mandatory that only recognised dental institutions can apply for increase in intake capacity, in the instant case, the applicant institute has started functioning only last year. It is only in view of the above Court Order that Government has taken this decision to allow the above intake capacity. This decision will not be taken as a precedent and existing regulations should be strictly adhere to.




