
SHOWING LOCATION AND ARRANGEMENT OF VARIOUS TEACHING DEPARTMENT




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
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#### GROUND FLOOR PLAN

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### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

# BETWEEN SINHGAD DENTAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL, PUNE

and

# SMT. KASHIBAI NAVALE MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL

Made on Date 29.01.2021 ("Effective Date")

This *MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING* (MOU) is entered into and is effective as on the date of the signatures

#### Between

## SINHGAD DENTAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL, PUNE

And

## SMT. KASHIBAI NAVALE MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL

SDCH and SMT. KASHIBAI NAVALE MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL shall be known collectively as "the Parties" and singularly as "a Party" or "the Party."

#### **RECITALS**

- WHEREAS, the parties agree and understand that cordial relations exist between SDCH and SMT. KASHIBAI NAVALE MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL; and
- WHEREAS, the Parties have discussed mutual goals regarding academic opportunities for their students and faculty; and
- WHEREAS, the Parties desire to conceive and establish a charter of possible collaborations for the benefit of the students and faculty members of their respective educational and research institutions; and
- WHEREAS, the Parties agree to promote Joint Education, Research and Development activities of Mutual interests in accordance with their respective needs and objectives.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties enter into this Memorandum of Understanding, in order to memorialize fundamental concepts regarding the Collaborations.



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### UNDERSTANDING OF THE PARTIES

In contemplation of establishment of the Collaborative Programs, the Parties agree as follows:

#### Article I: Objectives

- A. To contribute further understanding between both institutes (SDCH and SMT. KASHIBAI NAVALE MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL), in particular, through mutual cooperation programs.
- B. To promote collaboration between SDCH and SMT. KASHIBAI NAVALE MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL in terms of academic programs in instruction, research and faculty development among the faculty of both institutions.
- C. To enhance the educational experience of students from both institutions through a student exchange program between SDCH and SMT. KASHIBAI NAVALE MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL

### Article II: Roles and Responsibilities of the Parties

A. Both institutes commit themselves to identify concrete areas of academic collaboration and to explore the means to achieve a successful collaboration.

Eg.: Faculty and Students Exchange Programs, Instituting a joint academic program leading that leads to Writing and submitting joint funded research proposals, Organizing Summer/Winter academies, Participating in Conferences/Seminars/Development programs

B. Both institutes shall identify opportunities of academic staff exchanges and cooperation for joint instruction, Research and Development.

Eg.: The Parties will explore possibility of inviting upto TWO faculty members from SDCH to visit SMT. KASHIBAI NAVALE MEDICAL COLLEGE AND HOSPITAL and vice-versa once n a year. The Parties shall discuss and negotiate on such number of invitations purpose of visit, conditions of exchange, duration of stay and funding pattern. A separate agreement can be entered into, in respect of such faculty exchange program.

C. Both institutes shall identify opportunities of Students' Exchange at all levels (Bachelors. Masters, Research) with credit transfer in terms of coursework, project work, dissertation, internships.

Eg.: The Parties will explore possibility of recommending up to FOUR students for undertaking coursework, project work, research work, internship for a semester's duration or a year. The recommended students shall be selected through well-laid process, on the basis of merit and other non-discriminatory criteria. Each institute shall review the recommendations and consider offering scholarships/fellowships to eligible students. A separate agreement can be entered into, in respect of such Student exchange program.



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D. Each university/Institute can appoint representatives to mange and oversee the activities contemplated under MOU. The representatives of the Parties can meet as and when necessary to review progress and the implementation of activities related to areas of collaboration, define new areas etc.

#### Article III: Understanding of the Parties

- A. The Parties understand and agree that they are making a significant commitment to this collaborative effort. Accordingly, the Parties agree to expend their best efforts on the design, implementation, and successful continuation of the Program.
- B. The Parties understand and agree that this Memorandum of Understanding will provide the foundation for a more comprehensive agreement concerning the details of the Program.
- C. To implement collaborative activities envisaged under the MOU, the representatives of the Parties shall meet to discuss terms of financing /funding. Neither party shall have the power to bind the other party without other party's consent. The financial arrangement relating to each collaborative activity will be in accordance with specific project agreement and program of cooperation.
- D. The terms with respect to intellectual property, inventions and innovations (including trademark, service mark, copyright, patents, know-how and designs) will be negotiated on project-by-project basis in the specific project agreements and program of cooperation.
- E. SDCH reserves the right to use the project work for dissertation, publishing research work in scientific journal, presentation in any seminar / conferences, authorship rights of any article/book based on results obtained. A copy of such publication shall be provided to the other party.
- F. Despite the statements and obligations expressed herein, this MOU is a non-binding expression of the current intentions of the Parties and neither parties will incur nor be bound to any legal obligations or expense hereunder to the other party.
- G. This MOU shall remain effective from the date of execution until the end of the agreed upon term of THREE years. Thereafter it shall renew automatically, unless either party notifies the other party in writing a desire to terminate with notice period of ONE month.
